

LEARNING/TEACHING/TRAINING ACTIVITIES**Portugal – 7/10/2019 at 10/10/2019**

Third project planning meeting was held in Alcains, Portugal, in October. All partner schools sent representatives to the meeting. They arrived on Saturday and Sunday 8-9/10 and left on Friday 11/10.

Sunday 6/10: On Sunday, October 6, two teachers travelled to Lisbon by bus to receive the four delegations. After a city tour, the group made the return trip. The teachers stayed in Castelo Branco and the students in Alcains where they met their host families and with whom they went next.

Monday 7/11: The first day of work, Monday, October 7, was spent entirely at school. There was a reception in the school auditorium, followed by a tour/visit around the school. Lunch was in the cafeteria with the teachers and students. The students were always accompanied by a group of Portuguese students.

In the afternoon, the students had a tile workshop and the teachers had the first meeting for programming and project development work.

Tuesday 8/10: This day started with visits in Castelo Branco. The group began by visiting and enjoying the *Jardim do Paço Episcopal* (a 18 th Century Garden), followed by a brief visit to the City Park. This was followed by a visit to the *Museu Cargaleiro* where they could learn about the work of this artist born in the region. After the visit a tile workshop was held, inspired by the artist's work. Lunch was a picnic at the castle with a magnificent view of the city.

After a moment of socialising it was time to visit the Creativity Factory. Here they saw the material referring to the exhibition "From yesterday to today", opening soon, about the evolution of objects of our daily life, related to the various forms of communication and gadgets. This was followed by a photography workshop in which all participants were models and photographers. After the afternoon, the teachers stayed in Castelo Branco and the students returned to Alcains to the host families.

At around eight in the evening teachers gathered in Alcains for dinner, together with the teachers from another Erasmus + mobility taking place simultaneously.

Wednesday 9/10: The students spent the day at school with various sports activities, at the Library, and other activities proposed by the Department of Informatics and Traditional Games.

Lunch took place in the school cafeteria and after the activities the students returned home with their host families.

The teachers had a new working meeting on the project that began by aligning the presentations for the following day.

In the afternoon, in addition to getting to know the locality, the group of teachers visited the *Museu do Canteiro*, which represents one of the main economic activities of the locality and the *Santa Águeda* Dam.

Thursday 10/10: On Thursday, the last day of the meeting, the morning was spent at the elementary school and also with a visit to the preschool classes. The group was greeted with a song by the younger students. They visited the 1st cycle (primary school) classes and a 4th year class sang the Group Anthem.

As October 10th is Erasmus + Day there was a small celebration where the French delegation brought seeds, which were left in the school yard, and balloons.

Again at the headquarters school, lunch was in the cafeteria.

The week ended with performances, dances and songs from different countries.

In the late afternoon we had a social dinner with all the participants - students, teachers and the families that received the students in their home.

THE MAIN POINTS

We decided:

- This would be inserted on the first page of the project website, under the logo.
- Send the sounds to the teacher in charge to finish the dictionary online.
- In order to have the full story "The Wizard of Oz" at the end of the project, each delegation put their part on the website (video or photos).
- Also at this point, France undertook to buy history books for each of the countries involved.
- Application of the questionnaire to the agents involved: students, parents and local authority.
- Collaboration of all partners to develop a quiz.
- Greece was in charge of where the questions will be sent until January.
- Each country should build two questions about each section of the website (architecture, dance, music ...);
- Next Christmas, greeting cards would be exchanged again among children from various countries. Since France will, among the students involved in the project, exchange correspondence with Portugal and Slovenia.
- In order to make the photobook, 30 photos taken during this mobility, should be sent to France.
- The next mobility will take place on the theme of folklore and in Greece there should be the presentation of photos, videos and traditional dances.
- The project coordinator asked for evidence of activities on the website.

C4 Meeting in Greece: At school from Monday 23/03/2020 to Thursday 26/03/2020 – Travel on Saturday 21/03 or Sunday 22/03, return on Friday 27/03. The children will stay in host families.

C5 Meeting in Slovenia: At school from Monday 01/06/2020 to Thursday 04/06/2020 – Travel on Saturday 30/06 or Sunday 31/05, return on Friday 05/06.

Actions in November/December/January/February/ March in each school

-  Teachers organize cultural activities in local sites.
-  Each school will write his part of the newsletters: to write a souvenir of the meeting, with a photo to illustrate it.
-  Work with a website.
-  Prepare and send Christmas cards to partners.
-  Preparation of folklore performances to present in Greece in video or photos.
